“FUNKY B“ stands for the original Hammond B3 organ, artfully played by Markus Lauer, who has shared the stage with great musicians like Phil Guy and Big Joe Turner. Shuffleking Car, aka Carsten Egger, is known for his elegant yet ecstatic guitar playing and shares the lead vocals with Markus Lauer. The “third man” is drummer Shuffleking Jay, aka Jan Schneider from Aachen. He has a history in a range of blues, jazz and funk rock bands with whom he toured the Netherlands, Belgium and Germany.

The band's music, largely their own compositions, bursts with energy and groove – raw yet dynamic, eclectic yet cohesive. In every song, the interaction of the musicians has top priority. Egger, Lauer and Schneider put their hearts and souls into their music and on stage always deliver ... to the max.
